1. Application Procedure:

Applicants for the limited number of openings are processed in the order of their arrival. Ski Camp International, LLC must receive an Application signed by either parent or guardian and the applicant, accompanied by a deposit of \$800.00 US drawn on a US Bank which is refundable if the applicant is not accepted.

2. Payments, Refunds and Withdraws

A deposit of \$800 must accompany your application which is refundable if you are not accepted. The balance of your tuition is due upon acceptance but no later than March 1st, 2008. After March 1st, 2008, the full tuition must accompany your application. If you withdraw in writing before March 1st, 2008 you will forfeit \$500 of your \$800 deposit. If you withdraw after March 1st, 2008 you will forfeit your entire tuition.

If you leave a trip voluntary after it starts, there are no refunds. If you are sent home for disciplinary reasons (see rules and regulations) there are no refunds. If you must leave a trip after it starts because of an injury or ailment occurring we will refund any recoverable funds remaining. Because most of our expenses are based on total group costs, rather than individual costs, refunds can only be minimal. It is important for parents to understand that most trip group expenses are committed and are unrecoverable by Ski Camp International after March 1st, 2008.

3. Upon Acceptance

Upon acceptance, each participant will receive general trip information, travel information, a clothing list, reading list and a medical form.

The medical form must be filled out and signed by a physician certifying that the applicant is in good physical and mental condition. The applicant will be supplied with liability release forms. These forms must be signed by the parent/ guardian.

4. Expectations

Every Ski Camp International student is expected to be positive, motivated and physically fit with strong leadership and group skills. All students are expected to participate enthusiastically in all of the trip's activities and to shoulder trip responsibilities with a positive attitude.

The programs described on our website are well within the ability range of the vast majority of average young adults who have the desire to participate. Ski Camp International makes every effort, through the screening process, to be sure that those accepted into the programs are capable of handling both the mental and physical challenges offered. Ultimately, it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to assess the appropriateness of these programs for their daughter/son.

Participants who do not possess sufficient desire can become physically and/or mentally unable to complete a program. In such case Ski Camp International reserves the right to terminate the participation of said individual without a refund.

5. Rules and Regulations

Both parent/guardian and applicant understand that for the health, safety and welfare of all members of Ski Camp International, rules and regulations formulated by the staff members of Ski Camp International must be strictly observed. Ski Camp International has the right to terminate, without refund, the participation of any member that refuses to cooperate. In this case, return transportation expenses will be paid by the parent/guardian.

6. Health Report and Insurance Forms

The applicant will be provided with a medical form by Ski Camp International to be filled out and signed by a physician and parent/guardian certifying that the applicant is in good physical and mental condition.

This form must be returned to Ski Camp International within 30 days of notification of acceptance.

7. Risk/ Safety

There is some element of risk involved in skiing, snowboarding and other adventure related programs.

A signed application denotes that the parent/guardian and participant acknowledge this risk. For certain subcontracted activities, an additional signed agreement may be required by a subcontractor and will be forwarded by Ski Camp International to the participant and parent/guardian in late spring.

8. Medical Treatment

Ski Camp International shall have the right to give first aid to the participant and to engage the service of a physician or dentist, or to hospitalize a participant if it deems necessary. The cost of such service, including expenses for both the participant and the staff member who accompanies him/her during the period of illness and in rejoining the group, medicine and ambulance service, but excluding first aid service shall be charged to the parent/guardian and be paid by the parent/guardian.

9. Physical Exam Form/ Medical History Form Disclosure

Ski Camp International reserves the right to terminate, without a refund, the participation of any student whose physical exam form and medical history are found to have been falsified with regard to past treatment for physical, psychological, or emotional disorders.

10. Cancellation & Termination

If the trip is cancelled for any reason prior to its start, Ski Camp International shall refund the funds paid by the parent/guardian. If during the course of the trip it becomes necessary to terminate such trip, a proportion of the unused funds will be refunded.

11. Alterations in Itinerary

Our intention is to follow as precisely as possible the itinerary described on our website. Severe weather, unusually heavy snow or high water can necessitate an itinerary change. If an activity is deleted for any reason, it will be replaced with a comparable one.

12. Equipment Discounts

Ski Camp International has negotiated discounts on ski and snowboarding equipment that you might be interested in purchasing prior to your venture. Once you are accepted in the Ski Camp International program, we will send you further details on this exclusive program.

13. Equipment Loss or Destruction

The parent/guardian is to be held responsible for the willful destruction or loss by the participant of any equipment belonging to Ski Camp International, hotel, rental car companies etc. Parents should check their own insurance policies to make sure their son/ daughter's gear is covered against loss, theft or damage.

14. Change in Terms of Agreement

A signed application denotes that the signer understands and agrees that Ski Camp International reserves the right at any time to retract and change these terms and regulations and other conditions stated in the agreement or website and to make any other reasonable terms or regulations and conditions that it deems necessary for the safety and well being of the participant, his/her parent/guardian or Ski Camp International.

15. Personal Property Insurance

Ski Camp International does not cover the theft, loss, or damage of personal property and equipment of trip participants. We suggest that parents confirm that their insurance coverage includes items of this nature.

16. Governance

In the highly unlikely event a question or dispute arises from this contract, both, Ski Camp International and the participant, parent or guardian hereby agree that the said question or dispute will be settled within the state of Florida, the Palm Beach County and according to the Florida Law.

17. Model Release

The parent/guardian does herewith authorize and agree to the reasonable proper use by Ski Camp International of any and all photographs which may be taken of any aspect of the program and which may include the image of the participant.
